Bell Frogs

Bell frogs are one of the few types of frogs found in New Plymouth's Pukekura Park. They are originally native to Australia, but are now found in New Zealand and New Caledonia.

An adult bell frog is between S and ۱۱ cm long. They have a pointy snout, long legs and webbed back feet.

They have a good camouflage and like reedy environments.

Bell frogs are mostly aquatic and travel over land in periods of rainfall.

This species of frog is mostly found in wet and dry forests, grass lands, bog and coastal swamps and lagoons.
